










Key signatures appear at the beginning of sheet music and consist of sharps (#) or flats (b) that apply to certain notes throughout the piece. They serve as a guide to inform you which notes should consistently be played as sharp or flat, eliminating the need to mark each individual note. Every one of the 15 major keys is identified by its own distinct key signature.





The Circle of Fifths is a visual tool that musicians use to understand the relationships between different keys. It shows the sequence in which sharps and flats occur in key signatures. While this book doesn't cover the entire concept of the Circle of Fifths, knowing it can be very helpful for musicians who are learning their scales.

Assignment: Your task is to write out the 15 major scales daily after studying them thoroughly. You will use the test sheets provided, which accommodate 5 scales on each page.

For each scale, you should:

1. Write the key signature.

2. Place the notes correctly on the treble clef staff.

3. Label the note names on the accompanying keyboard diagram.

While it's optional, you are encouraged to also mark the sharps and flats on the treble clef staff. Even though the key signature indicates these alterations, actively writing them helps with memorization. This book contains enough sheets for you to practice for 30 days.
